- The member has read, understood, and accepted the rules of the shop. While on the premises of the shop, the member will follow the rules, policies, and procedures of both the shop and MIT, for the safety of all users.
- Membership is a privilege extended by the shop and MIT. Failure to abide by the aforementioned
 rules or conduct oneself in a safe manner may result in suspension or revocation of shop
 privileges, at the discretion of the shop management.
- The shop environment poses inherent hazards, and it is the responsibility of every shop member to be aware of these hazards.
- The member agrees to release and hold harmless the shop, MIT, its employees and agents with respect to any and all claims of any type whatsoever, including claims for bodily injury, personal injury or property damage arising out of activities at the shop.
